

## NSML CONSERVANCY MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 7, 2022

6 PM: Meeting called to order by Chairman Tom Trent

Attendance included Board Members: Bill Allen, Randy Hill, Tom Trent. Tim Johnson attended via FaceTime. Also 13 freeholders attended.

Minutes from January 27, 2022 were read and approved.

Treasurer Report: Randy Hill read treasurer report.

Checking 10,117.24

Business Checking 29,688.88

Maintenance: Dan Fox, maintenance supervisor from Astbury, gave a plant update.

The plant is operating at 43% capacity.

Field report: The main sewer line on the north end that has been blocked for over a year is now open and working properly.

Underground electric line for Grinder #5 was replaced.

Old Business: Tom Trent asked that amendment from 5-3-2004, Ordinance #030104-105-4, to be voted out. A vote was taken and approved unanimously.

Tom Trent mentioned Astbury offered to purchase the 2011 Dodge maintenance truck and the 2017 Kawasaki side-by-side for \$15,000. The offer was accepted and voted on unanimously.

New Business: Chairman Trent stated that he and Kevin from Astbury billing, and Brian Roller had been working on accounts to get freeholders paying properly and liens filed. This brought up the conversation of how far to go back to get freeholders caught up. It was decided to start from January 1, 2022 then work back.

The floor was opened for freeholder comments. The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 PM
